

Meaning of “Reportable Incidents” A Reportable incident includes but is not limited to the following occurrences:

- Acts of aggression towards staff and peers
- Property destruction-serious
- Any known criminal violation involving client or any staff member
- Off grounds or out of sight or supervision for more than 2 hours without your permission
- Non-compliance/refusal with medications or error medications
- In-school or out-of-school suspension
- Suspicion of drug use, possession, testing positive for drug use, or any known incidents of drugs
- Suspicion of sexual activity or any known sexual activity with staff or another student
- Any medical condition resulting in a trip to the emergency room or hospital
- Facility related issues, fires, floods-destruction of property
- Serious illnesses
- Serious injury-cutting, head-banging etc.
- Suicide attempt or suicidal ideation with a plan
- Any acts of non-accidental self-harm behavior including suicidal gestures
- Termination from employment of a client being served
- Incidents of contract or visitation with family members or others without the buyer
- Any incident the provider believes warrants the removal of the client from the provider approval
- Any allegation of child abuse or neglect by provider staff
- Any case of victimization as result of an aggressive act

AWOL: The provider shall immediately report all occurrences of absence without (AWOL) the Police, designated caseworker and caseworker’s supervisor. **CPS**
